Year 7

- Character programme for Year 7 aims to help students understand more about careers and the opportunities available. They will take part in the Buzz Quiz personality test: which animal they are most like and the ideal careers. This information will be used to explore different careers and plan for their future.

- All students will have the opportunity to speak to external visitors in regards to Careers

Year 8

Year 9
