Dear Parents /Carers

Recently some students have been challenged about their inappropriate footwear, academy ties not being worn and facial piercings in place. Staff will now be checking all uniform every morning before school to ensure that students are dressed appropriately.

The following consequences will be put in place for those students who do not follow academy uniform rules:

- Students will be **sent home** to change if we are able to contact a parent / carer.
- Be expected to **borrow spare** school uniform from the academy.
- Failure to wear the appropriate uniform will result an **hour detention** on the same day after school.

Staff will be contacting home to discuss as appropriate. Uniform will be put in place and consequences will be issued for students not following the academy uniform policy. If there are any issues with purchasing uniform a small window of time will be given to allow parents/carers the opportunity to purchase items. However, all students must be in full and correct uniform by **Monday 5th June 2017**. If this is not adhered to students will be placed in the isolation centre until this is rectified.

No trainers are allowed at all, this includes all makes such as Nike, Adidas and Vans pumps. Shoes that look like trainers will be challenged. If you are in any doubt please ask before purchasing.

Full correct academy uniform also consists of no facial piercings, such as nose or eyebrow piercing and only natural hair colours are allowed. Please feel free to contact me should you require any further information.
