Re: Year 11 Rewards System

To help support and motivate students in the build-up to their summer exams we have recently launched a rewards system. This system has been designed to earn money off a variety of end of year purchases, with money awarded or deducted from student totals as outlined below.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Attendance to each period 6 session• 100% attendance to period 6 in a week• Attendance to Saturday/holiday sessions• Receiving a praise postcard• Being on or above target in a subject at each progress check	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Arriving late to the academy day• Arriving late to a lesson• Receiving a detention

Through this system, each student will have the opportunity to earn up to £50 in addition to any positive points they achieve through the normal rewards system. These can be combined to help cover the cost of their prom ticket, leavers hoodie or end of year rewards trip.

We would like all of our students to earn enough money to cover as much of the cost of these purchases as possible, however I would like to take this opportunity to emphasise that these rewards are designed to reward students for their continued hard work and will not be available to any students who fail to meet our expectations. From now until the end of the exams students are expected to:

1. Act as positive role models for younger students by demonstrating good behaviour at all times.
2. Have an attendance of 96% or above or have significantly improved attendance. Valid medical reasons for poor attendance will be discussed.
3. Wear correct uniform at all times.
4. Arrive on time to the academy and lessons.
5. Work to the best of their ability in all lessons.
6. Complete any homework or revision task set.
7. Complete coursework by deadlines set by teachers.
8. Be respectful to all members of staff at all times.

Any students at risk of failing to meet these expectations will be given a 'Passport to Rewards' contract containing targets agreed by the academy that they need to achieve in order to receive their rewards or to attend events such as the prom. Failure to achieve these targets or any serious incidents such as those resulting in isolation or exclusion could result in the removal of these rewards.
