Week One – Update

Following what has been another challenging week we wanted to offer an update to you all. Firstly, we would like to say a big ‘well done’ to all of our Year 11 and SUA6 students for their attendance and engagement in lessons this week. Attendance has been around 90% to most of the lessons delivered through Teams and teachers have commented on how well the students have engaged, asking questions and sharing their work. Thankfully, a new shipment of laptops has now been delivered and we have today delivered replacements to those families who received a slightly damaged older laptops.
