Dear Parents / Carers,

End of the spring term

We are pleased to have completed the second term this academic year with an update for you all! When I last wrote, we were able to share that by the end of November we had collectively raised £1,708 for various charities. Since then we have supported the Save the Children campaign with our Christmas jumpers, NSPCC Number Day, National Aids Day, a charity football match in aid of MIND and Comic Relief. Comic Relief was an incredible success and the day went smoothly for all involved raising £1,070! Your generosity, and that of your children and the rest of Team SUA, sees the total for this academic year now at £3,495. Thank you – a superb effort, we are really proud of this achievement. Our students have recently raised funds to produce food parcels for Cannock Food Bank and they are currently fundraising for the Disasters Emergency Committee's Ukraine Humanitarian Campaign and the Year 11 prom.

The term has been very busy for the students, they have been really focused. There have been two further rounds of exams to support our Year 11 and 13 students in preparation for their formal exams this summer. Students have shown their determination and dedication to wanting to achieve in these exams and staff feedback has been incredibly positive. Across the rest of our academy, it has been brilliant to see all of the learning that continues to happen across our curriculum. Students are engaged, there is real sense of purpose and it is a pleasure for us to have conversations in lessons with them about their learning.

Now that the Covid restrictions have been lifted, we are delighted to reinstate our termly Parents' Forum. The first of which will be held on **Tuesday 26th April**, **6-7pm**. There will be a brief presentation and the opportunity for parents to raise items for discussion and debate. 
Students return to the academy on Tuesday 26th April at the regular time of 8.45am.
