Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 11 celebration event and timetables

As Year 11 come to the end of their time at SUA, may I take the opportunity to thank you and to thank them for all of their hard work over the years; it has been a pleasure to have been their Head of Key Stage.

The term will finish for Year 11 on Thursday 26th May after their exam. We will hold a celebratory special assembly and lunch for Year 11 on Friday 27th May. All students will need to attend from 11.30am and will have left the academy site by 1.15pm.

During the event students will not be expected to wear their uniform. There will be the opportunity for students to sign note books and shirts should they wish – however they will not be allowed to wander the academy to seek people out. Food, drink and activities will be provided for students in this celebration event.

During half term there will be a number of revision sessions to support students with their exams. Please support us by encouraging your child to attend as many of these sessions as possible, to help them in their preparations for their exams. As you will be aware, there are also additional sessions taking place from 3.00pm on a daily basis and your child is aware of these. The timetable for the half term sessions is overleaf.

After half term there is no requirement for Year 11 students to attend timetabled lessons unless they still have an exam for that subject. However, from Monday 6th June we are holding revision sessions for all students which they must attend. The timetable for Year 11 exams and revision for the first week after half term (6th – 10th June) is overleaf. When your child attends they are required to wear full academy uniform and come in for those sessions only. During this time Year 11 students can use the main entrance to enter the academy rather than the student entrance.

Finally, your child should have their individual examinations timetable. These have been emailed out to all students and copies are available in the Key Stage 4 office. Sitting GCSEs can be an intense experience for all the family. I advise students to revise regularly for short amounts of time, to take breaks and to make sure they are hydrated. I have shared with all students that this is a difficult few months but the benefits of putting the work in now is worth it for the feeling of elation when it is over. They do have to work hard but, as always, if you are worried about your child, please don't hesitate to contact your child's tutor at the academy.
